**CRAFTS & INFORMATION/SERVICE**

SPACE FEE: \$60/10'x10' space if received by 7/31/2025; ***\$70 after 7/31-no exceptions.*** \$20 fee for Non-Profits received by 7/31/25 ***\$30 after 7/31-no exceptions.*** There will be a \$35 charge on any checks returned.

SETUP TIME: Starting at 7:30 a.m., to be completed & operational by 9:00 a.m. All vehicles ***must enter Radcliffe Street from the South side (Mill Street)***, unload and immediately move from your assigned area so that other vendors may do the same.

LOCATION: Preliminary plans are to place the vendors in the 200 and 300 blocks of Radcliffe St., which will be closed to vehicular traffic from early morning to 5 p.m. You must enter Radcliffe Street from the South to unload and set up. There will be someone at the barrier to check you in. Please move your vehicle ***immediately after unloading your goods*** to street parking, to the free municipal parking lot behind Mill Street.

***You will only be notified by mail if your application is not accepted. You will not have your lot number until the morning that you come to set up. Your canceled check will be your confirmation, or you may call or email me for your confirmation.***

ACCEPTANCE: The BCHF has the right to turn away any applicant who has provided false or misleading information on the application, whose sales items/information services are deemed unsuitable for this event, or if there is too much duplication. In such cases, the paid fee will be refunded by BCHF at the earliest convenience.

SALES TAX: The vendors are responsible for all collections of PA sales tax.

SETTING UP: Participants are to arrive in time to have their displays complete, attended to and open to the public by 9:30 a.m. ***Between 8 and 11 a.m., complimentary refreshments will be served to vendors at BCHF headquarters, 321 Cedar Street.***

OTHER INFORMATION: Please no items with foul or vulgar language. Also, no politicking of any form. Permission to attend next year's event will be revoked if this is not followed.

CONTRACT: The dealers shall not transfer, assign or sublet this contract without the express written permission of the Bristol Cultural and Historical Foundation, Inc. prior to Historic Bristol Day.
