Perched atop a mountain ridge at the center of the planet's largest concentration of anthracite coal, Eckley Village is a world within a world. It was established in 1854 as a company-owned mining town. The Pennsylvania Historical & Museum Commission has owned and operated the village as a museum since 1970. 1-mile walking tour at slow pace; benches available. Wear comfortable shoes!
