Tentative Itinerary includes:


- Round-trip transportation, departing the Grundy Arena (475 Beaver Street, Bristol Borough) at 8:30 AM sharp. Vehicles have to be left in the first row facing Beaver Street.
- Estimated return time home is 7:00 PM.
- Guided Tour of Coe Hall and Planting Fields, the former estate of William Robertson Coe, insurance magnate and Standard Oil heiress Mai Rodgers Coe. This magnificent estate is one of the few remaining Gold Coast estates on Long Island that retains its original 409 acres, historic buildings and landscape. Visitors can enjoy the historic mansion, gardens and 2 greenhouses with unique displays.
- Guided Tour of Vanderbilt house, gardens and planetarium show. William Vanderbilt II loved the oceans and natural world collecting marine life, birds and cultural artifacts for his personal museum. He employed the architectural firm of Warren and Wetmore, who built Grand Central Terminal in NYC for his grandfather, to create this stunning Spanish Revival Style mansion on 43 acres situated on a hill above Northport Bay.
- Guided tour of Sagamore Hill, a 23 room Victorian wood and brick home, the primary residence of Theodore and Edith Roosevelt. From 1902-1908, it became known as the "Summer White House" and played host to visits from foreign dignitaries and peace talks that ended the Russo-Japanese War.
- 2 Expanded Continental Breakfasts and 2 Dinners including one Riverboat Dinner Cruise.
- 2 Overnight accommodations at the Hampton Inn in Commack, N.Y.
- Free time for lunch on own in Oyster Bay.
- Free time for lunch and shopping in Northport.
- Driver, escort and included restaurant tips included. Escort is Ellen Levy.
